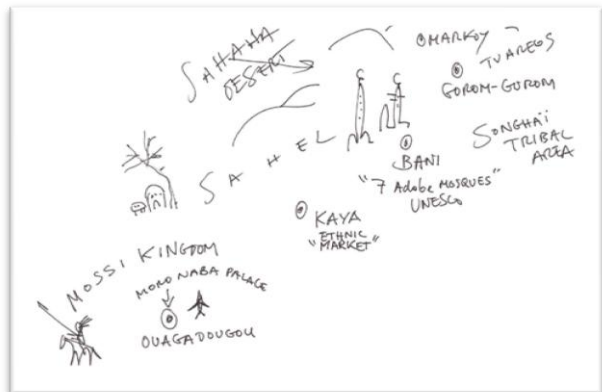


# GOROM GOROM

## LAND OF THE OURSI AND THE TUAREG

10 DAYS



Itinerary designed by our team of ethnologists to get to know the tribal groups of Burkina's remote North-east. This Sahel region has kept the essence of Africa's pre-colonial way of life. This tour explores the tribal land of the proud Tuareg people and the semi-nomadic Oursi, Bani's spectacular 7 mosques, the first dunes of the Sahara and some of Africa's most spectacular tribal markets.

**Required fitness level:** intermediate (take into account long distances, possible bad condition of the dirt roads and lack of hotels)

### DAY 1:

Arrival in Ouagadougou in the evening

### DAY 2:

Ouagadougou (explore picturesque Ouaga; the mud-brick quarter, the artisanal area and the Palace of Moro Naba, the Mossi King. Excursion to nearby Mossi and Bobo villages)

### DAY 3:

Ouagadougou – Boussouma - Kaya (on the way to Kaya there will be stops in different villages and on several markets)

### DAY 4:

Kaya – Bani (seven mosques, spectacular Sudanese architecture, homes-stay)

### DAY 5:

BANI- Dori (en route to the desert area of the North, land of the Fulani)

### DAY 6:

Dori – Gorom Gorom - Markoy (explore the colorful and lively ethnic market of Markoy, afternoon visit to the female gardens and the craft center)

### DAY 7:

Markoy – Korya Zena – Gorom Gorom (camel tour around the desert area, meet the Tuareg tribal groups and get to know their particular way of life)

### DAY 8:

Gorom Gorom – Dori – Kaya (several stops in order to become acquainted with the traditional Songhai and Mossi peasant cultures)

### DAY 9:

Kaya - Ouagadougou (day of transport and last shopping). In the evening: final departure

### DAY 10:

Arrival to European airport in the evening (if travelling with Royal Air Maroc one can visit Casablanca City Centre).

**Recommended Period:** All year round (some rain from July to October)
