

TOGO

FROM TOGOVILLE TO KARA

(10 days)

Togo is a wonderful country to get introduced to Black Africa. Its relatively small size but with a big contrast between the green, Animist South with the dry and Muslim North, allows the traveler to get a good grasp of what West Africa is all about. This itinerary starts in Lomé and moves towards the North to end up in the Atlantic beaches near Aného, where one can relax while eating some nice seafood.

Required fitness level: basic



DAY 1:

Arrival in Lomé in the afternoon

DAY 2:

Lomé – Atakpamé (we're in Ewé tribal area – Voodoo rituals, visit local villages and water falls)

DAY 3:

Atakpamé – Kara (we head up north – Sahel region, Muslim and Animist peoples. Visit Kara's central market)

DAY 4:

Kara- Kabyé Mountains (trekking around the mountains, visit traditional villages, night with local family or in tents)

DAY 5:

Kabyé Mountains – Kara – Lomé (drive south)

DAY 6:

Lomé – Agbodrafo - Pedakonji (drive through coconut plantations to Agbodrafo. Visit the ancient slave dungeons then continue to Pedakondji fishermen's village. Arrive at Pedakondji, experience the people's daily activities then continue to Glidji, the spiritual capital of the Guin Group. Night in local house)

DAY 7:

Pedakonji – Togoville (visit the shrines, meet the chief priest of the sacred forest and learn about the ceremony of the raising of the sacred stone. Tour proceeds on to Sewatsikope; cruise on Togo Lake to Togoville. Night at Mission)

DAY 8:

Togoville – Aného (Visit ancient German Cathedral, the traditional museum of the King of Togoville, be welcome by the king and his court. Cruise back to Sewatsikope and continue to fishing village around Aného. Hotel)

DAY 9:

Aného - Lomé (beach, relax and enjoy the local grilled seafood). In the evening return to Lomé for evening flight: **final departure**.

DAY 10:

Arrival to European airport in the evening (if travelling with Royal Air Maroc one can visit Casablanca City Centre).

Recommended period: All year round

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
